

Healing on the Streets Information Sheet



In 2005 a group of Christians from the Causeway Coast Vineyard Church in Coleraine, Northern Ireland, took to the streets simply to pray for people. Since that time they have seen God move in the lives of many of the people they have prayed for, including occurrences of actual healing. The leader of the initiative, Mark Marx, openly says that healing can come instantly, gradually or not at all – they simply say their best prayers and leave the outcome to God, and sometimes the outcomes are quite spectacular.

The Healing on the Streets movement has now spread to many towns and cities in the UK, including Bath, Taunton, Winchester and Kinson (near Poole). Our intention here in Weymouth and Portland is to further serve our community by launching Healing on the Streets in Weymouth Town Centre on Saturday May 22, 2010. The plan is that from that date, every Saturday morning from 10.30 to 12.30 (whatever the weather), we will gather a Healing on the Streets Team to offer prayer to anyone who will receive it. The experience of other initiatives is that people may be a little wary at first, but once they get used to you regularly being there, people do come forward to sit and be prayed for.

The Healing on the Streets approach to prayer is very simple and gentle – most who are prayed for receive some benefit from it. The approach does not require the people offering to pray to be Christian superstars – the approach is based on biblical principles and open to all.

Could you be part of the Healing on the Streets Team, willing to pray for people perhaps once every four weeks? If so, please complete an application form, ask your minister or pastor to provide a supporting signature, and return it to us. Training is planned for the evening of Friday 21 May, and Saturday 22 May at the Baptist Church in Weymouth. If possible, we'd also ask for a donation of £10 towards the costs of setting the initiative up (estimated around £2000), but please do not let this be a barrier to you stepping forward.
